The Board of Selectmen is in receipt of a report from the Police Chief regarding the Middlesex District Attorney's office alleging a possible alcoholic beverage service violation at Daniela's Tacorito on October 18, 2004. As you will see in Chief Widmayer's attached report, an intoxicated driver was stopped by Officer Krug on October 18, 2004, and when questioned, indicated he had been served at your establishment prior to the accident.

This is the third incident involving alleged over-service of alcohol at Daniela's Tacorito that has come to the attention of the Board of Selectmen in the last 10 months. The Selectmen consider this to be a serious violation of the responsibilities of a liquor license holder in the Town of Acton and have ordered a Hearing to determine what action, if any, they will take in this regard. The Hearing is scheduled for 8:00 PM on Monday, December 13, 2004, in Room 204 at the Acton Town Hall. You are requested to appear before the Board at that time to show cause as to why the Selectmen should not take action with respect to your license.

With regard to the upcoming December 13, 2004 Hearing, **the Selectmen have specifically directed that, in addition to yourself, any individual (other than yourself) who may have been on duty and in charge at the time of the alleged October 18th violation be present and available for questioning by the Board.**

Dear Mr. Miranda and Ms. Boyd:

In a letter dated February 10, 2004 (copy attached), you were advised that the Selectmen had scheduled a "show cause hearing" for March 8, 2004, to consider very serious allegations with regard to an incident on January 21, 2004 relating to the liquor service practices of Daniela's Tacorito. You were further cautioned that, on a similar, prior occasion, Daniela's Tacorito had failed to provide adequate representation at a scheduled hearing and you were directed to insure that anyone who was on duty and in charge at the time of the January 21 incident be present and prepared to testify at the March 8 Hearing.

On March 8, despite the clear direction of the Board, the Selectmen were quite disturbed to find that Daniela's Tacorito had, once again, failed to produce the individual who was in charge and responsible at the time of the incident in question. Accordingly, the Board continued the hearing to 8:00 PM on March 22, 2004, and has directed that Mr. Miranda, as owner of this establishment, appear personally at that time to show cause as to why the Selectmen should not suspend the Liquor License for Daniela's Tacorito. The Selectmen have specifically cautioned that a failure to appear and properly respond at this continued hearing will result in action by the Board.

The Board of Selectmen is in receipt of a report from the Police Chief alleging a possible alcoholic beverage service violation at Daniela's Tacorito on January 21, 2004. As you will see in Chief Widmayer's attached report, an intoxicated driver was involved in a single car accident on January 21 and, when questioned, indicated she had been served at your establishment prior to the accident.

This is the second incident involving alleged over-service of alcohol at Daniela's Tacorito that has come to the attention of the Board of Selectmen in the last four (4) months. The Selectmen consider this to be a serious violation of the responsibilities of a liquor license holder in the Town of Acton and have ordered a Hearing to determine what action, if any, they will take in this regard. The Hearing is scheduled for 8:30 PM on Monday, February 23, 2004, in Room 204 at the Acton Town Hall. You are requested to appear before the Board at that time to show cause as to why the Selectmen should not take action with respect to your license.

The Selectmen note that when you appeared before the Board on November 3, 2003, you provided general input regarding your understanding of the incident that had occurred in October but you were not present when the incident occurred and you did not bring anyone with you who was on duty or in charge at that time. With regard to the upcoming February 23 Hearing, the Selectmen have specifically directed that, in addition to yourself, any individual (other than yourself) who may have been on duty and in charge at the time of the alleged January 21 violation be present and available for questioning by the Board.







UNABLE TO PRODUCE HIS REGISTRATION. THE OPERATOR THEN SEARCHED FOR HIS LICENSE AND STATED "I HAD IT EARLIER I MUST HAVE LOST IT". THE OPERATOR AT THIS POINT IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS [REDACTED] I THEN EXPLAINED TO MR [REDACTED] THE REASON WHY I STOPPED HIM. DURING MY CONVERSATION WITH MR [REDACTED] I COULD DETECT A STRONG ODOR OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE. I OBSERVED MR [REDACTED]'S EYES WERE BLOODSHOT AND GLASSY AND HIS SPEECH WAS SLOW AND SLURRED. I ASKED MR [REDACTED] HOW MUCH HE HAD TO DRINK TONIGHT, HE STATED "A LITTLE BIT". I ASKED HIM WHERE HE WAS DRINKING, HE STATED "DANIEL'S CANTINA". I THEN REQUESTED FOR MR [REDACTED] TO STEP FROM THE VEHICLE TO PERFORM SOME FIELD TESTS. WHEN MR [REDACTED] STEPPED FROM THE VEHICLE HE WAS UNSTEADY ON HIS FEET. I ASKED MR [REDACTED] TO WALK OVER TO THE AREA OF WHERE THE GAS PUMPS ARE DUE TO BEING A FLAT SURFACE. AS HE WALK OVER TO THE GAS PUMPS HE WAS STAGGERING.

I FIRST DEMONSTRATED AND EXPLAINED THE NINE-STEP-TURN. DURING THIS INSTRUCTION PHASE MR [REDACTED] LOST HIS BALANCE TWICE, CORRECTING HIS FEET AND PLACE ONE FOOT BACK IN FRONT OF THE OTHER. AFTER EXPLAINING THIS FIELD TEST I ASKED MR [REDACTED] IF HE UNDERSTOOD THIS FIELD TEST, HE STATED "YES". MR [REDACTED] WALKED OUT ONE STEP AND LOST HIS BALANCE STEPPING OFF THE LINE.
