

Central Artery Tunnel (CA/T) Project (D008A), Route I-90, Logan Airport/Route 1A Interchange, Boston, Massachusetts. As Senior Project Engineer, I was closely involved with all aspects of construction phase services. As primary contact to the client, I responded to contractor's questions and coordinated the responses of the various sub-consultants on the design team. This coordination also included the affected agencies including the Massachusetts Port Authority, the City of Boston, and the Massachusetts Bay Transit Authority. Additionally, as notice to proceed was received on significant increases in design scope, I shifted my focus to the development and oversight of the civil/highway design. I also coordinated this revised design with the other disciplines on the team including structural, utilities and electrical. The completed design included revised off-ramps, at-grade intersections and modifications to several spans of existing steel viaducts.

Fay Spoffard and Thorndike (1996-1999)

CA/T Project (D008A), Route I-90, Logan Airport/Route 1A Interchange, Boston, Massachusetts. As Engineer-II, I designed horizontal/vertical alignments for a complex system of viaducts and embankments connecting I-90, Route 1A, the airport access and egress roadway system, Airport Station, and local streets. I also coordinated all roadway appurtenances, integrating each discipline's design including traffic, utilities, electrical, and mechanical.

CA/T Construction at Logan Airport. As a Civil Engineer, I represented the Massachusetts Port Authority (MPA) regarding CA/T construction. I was responsible for reviewing CA/T bid documents, design changes, contractor shop drawings and traffic control plans for compliance with MPA policies. I coordinated the construction between various MPA departments, CA/T Resident Engineers, and contractors.

As an Associate Traffic Engineer, I designed traffic signs, loop detector layouts and closed circuit television systems for the CA/T Project's Traffic Surveillance and Control System (TSCS).
