





I have reviewed the application for the Class II License Application and I have concerns. Mr. Hryniewich has indicated on his application he has an "area for storage of these vehicles at a commercial property". If the property, where the storage is proposed, is located in Acton it should be identified. My concern is if the property is properly zoned for vehicle sales.

If the property is located in an adjacent town, the license could be applied for at that location. In the alternative, if the storage location is in an adjacent town and that town is comfortable with the license being in Acton, a letter from that municipality should be provided confirming the arrangement.
