Subject: Parking on Keefe Road

Over the last several months this Office and the Police Department have received requests to review parking conditions on Keefe Road. As part of our review we have:

Reviewed the written and verbal requests of abutters.

Reviewed the recommendations of the East Acton Village Plan.

Inspected the location with Police Department, Fire Department, Highway Department and Engineering Department Officials.

Our site inspection determined that private no parking signage has been put up by the abutters. This signage is not enforceable by the Police Department. However the no parking signs along the buildings (West Side) made sense and should be adopted officially by the Town. The Police can then enforce the signage.


The East Acton Village Plan recommends that by 2007 permanent parking be established on the East side of Keefe Road. With No Parking officially adopted by the Town on the West side, the Town Official's inspecting the site determined that there is adequate room to allow the continued parking on the East Side of the Road. A white "Fog Line" would be painted along the east side to guide parkers. This office will work with the Planning Department to fully implement the recommendations of the East Acton Village Plan.

We encourage the abutters to maximize their off street parking and minimize their use of Keefe Road for parking.

Included with this correspondence is a copy of the proposed parking plan being presented to the Selectmen for adoption in the Town's Traffic Rules and Orders. The Selectmen will hold a public hearing in the Town Hall on June 20, 2005 at 7:30 pm to discuss this matter.

Keefe Road – on the south side facing easterly
(Originally Voted on November 8, 1983)

Keefe Road – No Parking signage on the westerly and easterly sides, pursuant to the plan entitled "Keefe Road , Acton, MA, No Parking Location Plan, Scale 1" = 60', Date May 31, 2005 by the Town of Acton Engineering Department (Attached herewith).



Amendment to the Existing Traffic Rules and Orders

Voted: That the Traffic Rules and Orders adopted by the Board of Selectmen under date of March 25, 1937, are hereby amended by adding to the end of Article VIII, Section 7 (Obedience to Isolated Stop Signs) the following new locations:

New Stop Signs on Existing Streets

1. To install a Stop sign so as to face the eastbound drivers on Eastern Road at Main Street (Route 27).
2. To install a Stop sign so as to face the westbound drivers on Notre Dame Road at Squirrel Hill Road and Arlington Street.

Existing Stop Sign on a New Street

3. To authorize by vote the existing Stop sign facing the westbound drivers on Dunham Lane at High Street.
