- 1) I believe there was something in the contract that promised coverage of other town boards besides the Board of Selectmen. So far the only boards covered are the Selectmen, School Committee and FinCom. I would like to see the quality of the coverage improved as well, be it through better equipment or training of cable TV personnel. Citizens who do watch the local channel complain of poor sound and fuzzy visuals, as well as an unpredictable viewing schedule.
- 2) There has been an improvement in the number of meetings of interest to the community covered such as League of Women Voters and others. There has also been some local programming such as cooking shows, and productions from out of the school community. I'd like to know how they plan to encourage more of this typ of community produced programming.
- 3) Has there been any customer outreach to find out who is watching the local cable channel and what type of programming they would like to see? I'd be interested in finding out the size and scope of the local Cable TV audience.
