* One of our neighbor's on Pope suggested I send photos looking at the Pope Brabrook intersection from the north. Photos are from Mar 2, 2005.

- Photo 1: Taken from Wingate Lane entrance looking south down Pope toward Brabrook at my Jeep parked on Brabrook
- Photo 2: Taken from center lane Pope opposite Wingate Lane entrance looking south down Pope toward Brabrook, Jeep no longer visible.
- Photo 3: Taken from center lane Pope at driveway entrance to Emma Sarno's 50 Pope Rd residence looking south down Pope toward Brabrook, Jeep still not visible.
- Photo 4: Taken from center lane Pope at large tree to the south of Emma Sarno's 50 Pope Rd residence looking south down Pope toward Brabrook, Jeep now visible.
- Photo 5: View to the north of the large tree photo 4 was taken next to. Also observe the continuing slight curve leading to the hill people accelerate up when heading south from Stonymeade.
- Photo 6: Taken from driveway entrance of Rita Spence's 42 Pope Rd residence looking south down Pope toward Brabrook, Jeep visible.
- Photo 7: Taken from center lane Pope at driveway entrance to Rita Spence's 42 Pope Rd residence looking south down Pope toward Brabrook, Jeep visible.

Clearly, the Pope / Brabrook intersection is even more dangerous in the winter.






