- Arts and Crafts Supplies (solvents)
- Asbestos
- Asphalt Shingles
- Batteries
- Brush
- Cathode Ray Tubes
- Cement Blocks
- Computer Monitors
- Concrete
- Dirt (Sand, Gravel and Stone)
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs
- Fluorescent Light Fixtures with Ballast
- Gasoline
- Medical Waste
- Mercury Devices and Liquid Mercury (thermostats/switches)
- Lumber more than four (4) feet in length
- Oil paints and stains
- Pesticides
- Photo Chemicals
- Pool Chemicals
- Pressure Treated Lumber
- Propane Tanks (large or small)
- Railroad Ties
- Sheetrock
- Stones
- Stumps
- Televisions
- Thinners and Solvents
- Tires on Rims
- 55 Gallon Drums (unless cut half)
