Ladies and gentlemen:

The Acton Historic District Study Committee is pleased to present to the town its Final Study Report on Local Historic Districts in Acton. This is an amended version of our Preliminary Report, which was submitted on August 10, 1990. It incorporates suggestions and comments from the general public, residents and owners of property in each of the three proposed districts, from the Massachusetts Historical Commission, Acton Town Counsel, and from several Acton boards, departments, commissions and committees.

As you have seen in the final draft of October 24, many revisions were made in the Bylaw. The Background/Methodology section outlines the most significant changes, and also includes additional Study Committee recommendations for the guidelines and rules and procedures of the District Commission. The boundaries of two of the proposed districts have been changed, with two properties added in South Acton, and seven deleted in West Acton. The report is now in the Planning Office, with an additional copy in the library.

We thank you for your help on the development of the Local Historic Districting proposal, and look forward to your support at the November Special Town Meeting.
