Dear All,

Following up with Mr. Chip Chapin's email regarding the above subject matter, I hearby notify you, due to the blasting of bedrock for water main connection to Ellsworth Village, our wells have been contaminated with perchlorate.

Pre-blast test performed on September 26, 2005 detected no perchlorate. First post-blast test performed on March 6th, 2006 showed 1.38 ppb and the follow-up confirmation test taken on March 29th, 2006 detected 2.43 ppb.

I urge the Town of Acton and James Fenton and Son General Contracting to act promptly to provide us with corrective action and reimburse us for the water testing and drinking water.
