



## ACTON PLANNING BOARD

### Minutes of Meeting March 14, 2006 Acton Memorial Library

Planning Board members Mr. Greg Niemyski (Chairman), Mr. Christopher Schaffner (Vice Chair), Mr. William King, Mr. Edmund Starzec, Mr. Gary Sullivan, Ms. Ruth Martin, Mr. Michael Densen and associate Mr. Bruce Reichlen attended. Also present was Town Planner, Mr. Roland Bartl and Planning Board Secretary, Ms. Kim DeNigro.

Absent was Mr. Alan Mertz.

Mr. Niemyski called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

#### **I. Citizens Concerns**

Resident, Mr. Chip Chapman, 4 Brabrook Road, was concerned with the truck traffic and speeds on Brabrook Road and work ongoing after 5 pm at the Ellsworth Village construction. Mr. Niemyski indicated to Mr. Chapman his concerns should also be brought to the Building Commissioner. Mr. Bartl stated he will contact the developer regarding these issues.

#### **V. 68 Willow Street Decision - Vote**

#### **VI. Heritage Landscape Inventory – Appointment with Mary Ann Ashton**

Mrs. Mary Ann Ashton explained the Heritage Landscape Inventory Program is a relatively new addition to the host of landscape programs offered by the Massachusetts Department of Conservation & Recreation. The program builds upon prior landscape survey efforts to identify and document those heritage landscapes of our Commonwealth that are vital to the history, character and quality of life in our communities. She discussed the development of a pilot program to create a list of potential heritage landscapes in Acton and the upcoming meeting in this regard. Mrs. Ashton invited the Planning Board to attend. The Board Chairman thanked Mrs. Mary Ann Ashton for her time and effort to explain the project.
