Also, I wanted to provide the following clarifications regarding the draft memorandum of understanding (MOU):

During the remedial design and all phases of the cleanup EPA and MA DEP are legally required to follow the CERCLA guidelines. Comments that are consistent with CERCLA requirements may be incorporated into the design however all comments will be considered and become part of the administrative record. The schedule for commenting on the deliverables is not arbitrary. It is based on the approved RD/RA Statement of Work. The comment timeframe outlined in the MOU is attempt to provide the community an opportunity to comment within the schedule approved in the RD/RA SOW. The MOU is an effort to get consensus from the community on the community involvement process during the remedial design so the remedial design could be implemented in a timely manner. The MOU is non binding and no one was asked to sign it.
