The application was approved unanimously by the Historic District Commission at a meeting on June 15, 2009 for the installation of your basketball system. Please note the Condition placed on the Certificate.




Description of Proposed Work:

Installation of an in-ground basketball system on lower driveway between garage doors on Nagog Hill Road side of property. Manufacturer - Goalrilla Goal GS - one piece, black steel pole bolted into ground, 54" clear-view glass backboard, orange flex rim with net.

Conditions, Requirements, Recommendations:

Condition: Install shrubs along stonewall, adjacent to lower driveway and garages, to screen basketball system.

The work outlined above must conform in all particulars to the submittals and conditions approved on June 15, 2009. The applicant may proceed with the proposed work provided all other approvals have been obtained, including a Building Permit or Sign License where required.
