
Findings, conditions, requirements, recommendations:

On Condition:

1. Sign shall be a non-illuminated 2' by 7' wood sign with vinyl letters with a black background with no flourish.
2. Gold-colored lettering shall be the font indicated in the application in with slightly more space between the 'Q' and 'Nails' than noted on the mockup.
2. Sign shall be centered over the bay window and between the bay window roof and the windows of the second floor.

When completed, the work outlined above must conform in all particulars to the Application approved on Feb. 9, 2010. The applicant may proceed with the proposed work provided all other approvals have been obtained, including a Building Permit or Sign License where required. This Certificate is valid for work commenced within one year of the date of issuance. An extension or renewal of the Certificate may be granted at the discretion of the commission. If a property changes ownership during the time the Certificate is in force, a new owner who wishes to continue the authorized work must apply to have a new Certificate issued in his or her own name.
