

# EXHIBIT 5

## Use Description

In 1982, the Acton Housing Authority acquired this site. In 1986, the AHA developed 12 units of public housing for families and 23 units of elderly housing.

These buildings occupy about 60% of the site. The remaining 40% (or 2.5 acres) remains forested. This is the land that will be developed to create 12 new units of family housing. The new housing will include 9 two-bedroom units (including one handicap-accessible unit) and three three-bedroom units. Each unit will have two parking spaces. All of the units will be rental housing. Tenants will pay 30% of their income toward rent.
