--First, finish reviewing/commenting on the draft inventory. Even if you are not inclined to make detailed comments, I think it is important that we all have reviewed the document in detail to know what is in there. So, **please forward any more comments you have on the draft inventory chapters by MONDAY, January 10th.**

--Second, since we did not have our meeting on Wednesday to discuss live with Daphne our comments on the Revised Goals and Objectives, in order to expedite this revision, I'd like those of you (which includes myself) who haven't done so already, **to send any written comments to Daphne on this document (focusing only on the goals and objective, NOT on the Ideas for Strategies) by Monday, January 10th.** In order so that we don't repeat comments, Daphne has already made another draft of the Revised Goals and Objectives that incorporates the comments she has received so far. Please see attached documents as well as Daphne's explanation of the documents below

--Third, Jim has created a document that is a starting list of "burning issues" that he and others have identified. He will be sending you all a link to this document shortly. **Please read through these and add your own.** If you are meeting with any committees in the near future, this is a good list to have to take with you to discuss with the committees and get their reaction.

--Finally, **continue thinking on someone who might make a great addition to our committee.**

Please send any comments you have on these to me by Monday and be prepared to discuss and finalize the Goals and Objectives (not the strategies just yet) at next Wednesday's meeting.

After we have finalized the Goals and Objectives structure, The Consultant Team will then review the strategies and we will send you another draft to begin to work on sifting through, thinking about feasibility, and prioritizing strategies. Once the Committee has reviewed these, we will then present these to the public for their ideas and response.

PLEASE NOTE: There are two versions of the new draft attached:

DRAFT 2 is the document with all the tracked changes (if anyone feels that they would like to see what was changed)

DRAFT 2B is the document with the changes accepted; the document being offered to you for your review.
