

ADDENDUM NUMBER 2
REQUEST FOR BIDS
TOWN OF ACTON
Former Caouette Property (DEP RTN 2-0018007) and
Abutting Portion of Former MBTA Property (DEP RTN 2-0017998)
Stow and Maple Streets
Acton, Massachusetts

The Town of Acton amends the Remediation Activities Request for Bids (“RFB”) for the Former Caouette Property and the Abutting Portion of the Former MBTA Property in Acton (collectively the “Site”) as follows:

The Request for Bids (“RFB”) indicates that the Work will be conducted pursuant to a Release Abatement Measure (“RAM”) Plan. Based on information provided to the Town’s Licensed Site Professional (“LSP”), James Okun of O’Reilly, Talbot and Okun Associates (“OTO”), by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (“DEP”) on October 17, 2011, the Work may be conducted pursuant to an Immediate Response Action (“IRA”) Plan. In either case, the scope of the Work will remain substantively unchanged from that described in the RFB and the RAM Plan attached as Exhibit A thereto. Under an IRA Plan, DEP may, however, impose conditions on the Work as it proceeds.

OTO is currently preparing the IRA Plan for submittal to DEP. The IRA Plan will not be available before the Bid Opening Date of October 19, 2011, but a copy will be provided to the Contractor when it is submitted to DEP.
