

Spill Control and Countermeasure Plan

In the event of a fuel spillage, please contact the appropriate authorities listed below as emergency contacts. Next utilize the on-site spill containment kit and wait for the arrival of the responding party.

In the event of a contained spill, please contact Tom Rogers at the number listed above and follow the posted directions for proper spill clean-up.

In the event of an uncontained spill resulting in the release of oil or hazardous materials to the environment, contact the Fire Department, the Waste Disposal/Clean-up Contractor and the Emergency Response number for Mass DEP (listed below). Remain on site and be prepared to assist emergency responders and to provide the Fire Department with the material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) from the maintenance shop in addition to a copy of the Spill Control and Countermeasure Plan.

If you are unable to reach Tom Rogers, please contact the Director of Property Management, Dave Potenza and the main office at 781-272-7000. If it is afterhours, the answering service will be able to contact the other members of maintenance if back-up assistance is needed.
