Hello Pat,

Since I do not have the BOS email address , I would appreciate your forwarding the following letter from us, Allan B. Pooler and Louise POOLER

We at Robbins Brook have been involved with this ongoing dispute with Axe Bros for far too long. I wish to emphasize the following points :

1. There never was a problem with noise, dust, and health issues until Axe Bros commenced processing firewood in blatant violation of zoning and related issues.
2. The proposed noise abatement proposal may possibly reduce noise but will NOT ELIMINATE noise.
3. The fact that Robbins Brook is situated on what was a lumber yard does not give Axe Bros the green light to produce higher levels of noise.
4. Many residents of Robbins Brook have medical conditions I.e. Assisted living matters. Many have limited incomes and as such, cannot just pick up and move somewhere else.
Axe Bros can process wood elsewhere and in fact do. Many of us have seen them elsewhere in nearby locations.
5. Many of us here at Robbins Brook have been and still are active in Acton civil affairs, church activities, chorus groups, volunteer groups, and other activities which are a benefit to the town.
But now, we are spending time and money so that ONE, repeat ONE entity, Axe Bros, can disrupt the peace and quiet in our backyard. It does NOT make sense at all.
6. YOU have a legal and moral obligation to do what is best for the town as a whole....not just for the Axe Bros. Axe Bros can do their main business of land clearing wherever the land needs to be cleared, but there is no sense, ABSOLUTELY NO sense in describing the wood processing as a boon to promoting small business . We all would like to promote sensible and responsible small business in our town. PROCESSING WOOD at 848 Main Street does not fit the description of promoting small business.
