Please allow me to introduce myself. On Wednesday, I was elected Chair of the Acton 2020 Committee. I wanted to reach out to you and the EDC members and briefly touch base regarding the Kelley's Corner RFP, but more important I hope to discuss ways in which we can work together.

Acton 2020 appreciates the EDC's review of the RFP and for the extra time you as a Committee took to conduct your review.
