



Sign Details for 115 Great Road Free Standing Sign

The existing historic structure restored and placed known as the 1910 Sears & Roebuck House used by the Station Master of the waterways of Acton.

Please note as this is a historic home it needs to meet the historic sign by-law, which is very difficult to achieve following the by-law to its limit. As you know this historic by-law has its set dimensions on every piece of sign and matter there on. For the sake of the tenant of 10 years we would like to provide a minimal 8 sq. ft. free standing sign.

This sign shall be located 39 ft. out towards Route 2A and in the center of the property line from Littleton to Acton 123 ft. to the light pole (Eversource) and sign is to be center 75 ft. to provide the location.

This location is more than 33 ft. from the historic structure and out of the state lay out.
