Hi Kristen,

Yes, the Conservation Commission was satisfied with the project as presented. Of note, the Commission expects the applicant to install signs along the stonewall near the vernal pool, indicating that this is a sensitive environmental area. The applicant is aware that the vernal pool should not be exposed to additional sunlight, which may require some trees be planted along the stonewall. The Commission was not interested in seeing a trail or walking path be added to the plans connecting 248 High Street to the "common land" associated with Dunham Lane.
